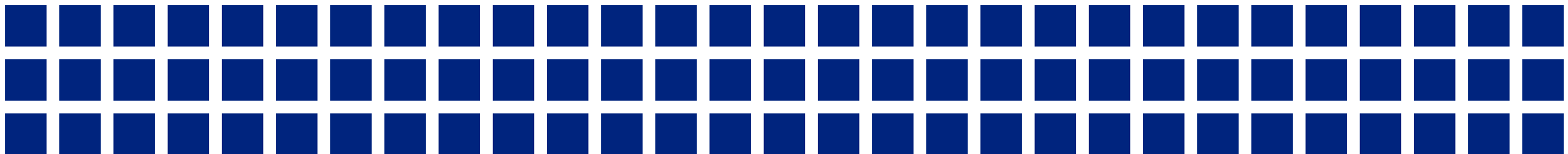

# Benefits



- On-line shopping
  - Easier access to preferred suppliers
  - Easier access to negotiated prices
- Automate each step of the purchasing process
  - Reduced cycle time as a result of electronic processing
  - More efficient invoice receipt/processing
  - Improved timeliness of financial commitment
- Order Processing Improvements
  - Reduce maverick spending (spot buys)
  - Increase the percentage of P-Card purchases transacted via e-commerce.
  - Replace less efficient Direct Orders and Standing Order transactions with P-Card transactions.
  - Decrease the volume of Direct Orders and Standing Order transactions.
  - Improve contract compliance rates

# Benefits



- Cost savings
  - Improved savings as more transactions flow to Tigerbuy contracts
  - Reduce use of less efficient purchasing methods such as blanket orders
- Improved Business Processes and Compliance
  - Increased throughput of completed orders for reporting and purchasing analysis
  - Provide line item transaction data for Purchasing Card (P-Card) purchases, to enhance auditing and tracking capabilities
  - Improve visibility, tracking, analysis, and reporting of purchasing and contracting transactions
  - Realize return on investment (ROI)
  - Improve strategic procurement initiatives to influence spend through negotiated contracts
  - Enhance strategic sourcing capabilities, including an increase in small, minority and woman owned businesses
